After discussion, a motion was made, seconded, and carried unanimously to approve the modifications to the rules, 64B8-30.015 and 64B15-6.011, F.A.C. A motion was made and seconded that the proposed rules will not have an adverse impact on small business and will not likely to directly or indirectly increase regulatory costs to any entity in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate in Florida within one year after the implementation of the rule. The Council also voted “no” to minor violation and “no” to adding a sunset provision to this rule. The motion carried unanimously.
